**Re: Patching works: Road from Burrow Knap to Sheppards Knap, Dalwood**

Circumstances and weather permitting, SWH will be undertaking essential highway maintenance works in the vicinity of your property on behalf of Devon County Council, between **Monday 29 June** and **Wednesday 01 July**. Please be aware however that these dates may need to change at short notice.

The works will involve essential **patching** works in the highway. In order to carry out these works, a road closure will be in place. The signed diversion route is illustrated in blue on the map overleaf.

Work generally will be undertaken between the hours of **07:00 and 18:00**, although these times may vary.

We will endeavour to maintain access to your property at all times and to keep any inconvenience to a minimum, although some interruption may be unavoidable and for this we apologise in advance. If you are a resident within the closure, please speak to the operatives on site who will arrange for you to access your property at the earliest opportunity.
